

Significant comments re District Plan from workshops 18/10 and 8/11

DP3 – NP Village Development - Policies should reflect differing needs / styles of the main settlements

DP8 Countryside – Give consideration to definitions of built-up area boundaries

DP9 Coalescence – NP Policy needs to define WH / Sharpthorne local gap

DP10 Rural Dev and Economy – NP will need to be more precise / detailed re rural development

DP11 – New Homes in Countryside - requires more detailed work / definition (linked to DP10)

DP12 – AONB - again linked to DP11 and DP10. Also, triggers need to address Philpotts quarry traffic

DP16 Sust. Tourism – NP should encourage safe circular and access routes for cycling

DP18 Transport – NP will need additional coverage of public transport options

DP19 RoW and Rec routes – We should try to define some specific RoW routes – linked to DP16 as well

DP21 Leisure and Cult facilities – NP needs to cover our specific open spaces and cultural/community/sports facilities

DP22 Comm. Facilities & Services – linked to DP21 plus health services provision in Parish

DP23 Character and Design – Query if we need provisions re domestic garden space available at dwellings

DP24 Dwelling Space – What about outdoor storage / parking standards for dwellings

DP26 Pollution – NP should cover the light pollution local concern. Do we need extra on noise?

DP27 Housing mix – NP will identify specific Parish development sites and mix needed

DP28 Affordable Housing – NP should bolster Affordable housing provision

DP31 Listed & other bldgs of merit – NP should identify other buildings of merit

DP32 Cons Areas – NP will highlight Parish Conservation Areas

DP35 Biodiversity – Need specifics re biodiversity in our open spaces

DP38 Renewables in new devs – Should NP have provisions re energy demands of extensions

DP39 Renewables schemes – NP could encourage in Parish schemes – eg solar on public buildings

DP41 Water infrastructure – We need to understand status of local water supply and waste disposal
